Information concerning travel & entry restrictions for Austria

NEW entry requirements for Austria

Innsbruck, 13.01.2021

Dear all,

due to Covid-19 pandemic, new measures to contain the Covid-19 virus have been tightened. The regulation coming into force with Friday, 15.01.2021 means that entry into Austria is from that on only possible under the following conditions:

- From Friday, 15.01.2021 on all persons entering Austria are engaged to register through the “Pre-Travel-Clearance-Form” (also mandatory for children!).
- The registration has to be done upon arrival online via the following link:

After your successful registration you will get a copy as well as a QR-Code. This serves as your backup for potential boarder-controls.
Furthermore a negative PCR or antigen Test (not older than 72 hours) is mandatory and also the attached certificate by a doctor needs to be uploaded via the online registration (see annex D “Medical certificate”)
- **When entering Austria from abroad, a quarantine of 10 days after entry is obligatory.** This quarantine is not relevant if you are competing / working at
 - Worldcup or Europacup competitions in Austria with National Interest and if you have a copy of the letter from the Federal Ministry with you. This exception is only valid for registered participants as well as for anyone required behind the scenes for Worldcup and Europacup competitions.
 - **FIS-Races are not from National Interest and therefore no exceptions can be done concerning the 10-days quarantine.**

- **Summing up you what you need for you travel to Austria:**
 - Online registration as described above upon arrival
 - Invitation letter from the Austrian ministry (available through the LOC for WC & EC)
 - Confirmation, that you are professional Athlete (from your Ski Association)
 - Negative antigen / PCR Test not older than 72 hours certified by a doctor (see attached)

Important information for Team Captains

FIS & EC Races Austria



Dear team captains. Please read through the following rules very carefully. These regulations are established by the Austrian Federal Ministry of Health, Austrian Ski Federation and the LOC in cooperation with FIS. It is your responsibility to inform your entire team and make sure all members follow these rules without exceptions.

1. What is important:

- Take personal responsibility very serious
- hygiene measures at all times (regular hand washing, regular disinfection)
- maintain a minimum distance of 2 meter in all areas (social distancing)
- wear mouth and nose protection at all times
 - on the entire event site, except
 - during meal
 - during the practice of sport
 - in the start area right before the start
 - inside all buildings
 - for all transports in buses, shuttles, gondolas, chair lifts
 - in the common areas of your accommodation

2. COVID-19 tests:

- Everbody (athletes, coaches and staff) who wants to get an accreditation for the event needs to present a negative COVID-19 test result (PCR or*Antigen not older than 72 hours before the first race start). The negative test result must be presented when collecting the accreditations.
- **Accreditation for persons with a previously diagnosed COVID-19 infection**
 - present the PCR COVID-19 positive test result made between 2 weeks and 3 months before the arrival
 - free of COVID-19 symptoms for a minimum of 3 days before arrival

* Antigen Tests for Villach must be conducted <24hrs prior to the TCM

3. Daily Health Questionnaire for athletes, coaches and LOC: Link will be provided on the FIS Event Description

- has do be filled out and sent online mandatory every morning before showing up at the bottom station of the gondola (will be controlled)

4. Team Captains Meeting (TCM): Online via Zoom Meeting. Link will be provided at the FIS Event Description as well as prior your arrival

5. Transportation rules for cars/team busses:

- max two people can be carried in each row of seats
- wearing FFP2 mask is mandatory

6. Rules for Hotel/Accommodation:

- professional athletes and coaches are allowed to stay in hotels, closed for the public
- FFP2 mask mandatory, except at the table while meals

7. Transportation rules for gondola/chairlift:

- checkpoint bottom station for the correct questionnaire by the COVID-19 Manager
- **FFP2 masks mandatory** for gondola, possibility to get one at the bottom station
- FFP2 mask for chairlift
- half capacity at all times
- staggered, team by team

8. Avoid crowds: inspection, toilets, gondola, chairlift

- spend your free time only with members of your team in small groups

9. COVID-19 Communication

- in case of COVID-19 symptoms immediately inform the COVID-19 Manager who is responsible for the Event (Details will be provided at the TCM)
- COVID-19 Manager activates the necessary COVID-19 measures
- all communication regarding COVID-19 must be coordinated with LOC and FIS





Villach COVID-19 Prevention:

The LOC understands the realization of an international FIS-Cup in the middle of a pandemic as a privilege. For this reason, we will execute a 'zero tolerance policy' for deviations from legal regulations and FIS/OESV (Austrian Ski Federation) guidelines. The health and safety of everyone involved in the competition has the highest priority.

Athletes, Team-Captains, officials, jury, LOC and volunteers are responsible for their compliance with the statutory regulations, as well as prevention guidelines in their respective areas of activity.

Each participant and the National Ski Associations confirming with their entry, to comply with national legal requirements, and guidelines by the FIS and the Austrian Ski Federation (OESV).

Risk Management & Testing Protocol

In addition to the 'Ski Austria Guidelines', the Villach LOC has used the 'FIS Covid-19 Prevention Guidelines' and the 'FIS Covid-19 World Cup Risk Management and Testing Protocol' as a reference to define the procedures, requirements, roles and responsibilities to eliminate or minimize the risk of COVID-19 transmission during the Villach FIS-Cup. The LOC utilizes a separate 'COVID-19 Prevention concept' document, in alignment with the Villacher Alpen Arena and local authorities.

National Health Regulations are paramount!

Testing prior to arrival at Venue & Health Questionnaire

The venue is secured to prevent unauthorized access in the period from Friday 9am until the end of the competition on Sunday afternoon.

Every person who wishes to access a FIS Event must have and present a negative Covid-19 Test result carried out prior to arrival at the Villacher Alpen Arena venue.

The LOC accepts Covid-19 RT-PCR Tests which are conducted <72h prior to the TCM and Antigen-Tests <24h prior to the TCM. The test needs to be performed by an authorized test facility, and confirmation in the 'Medical Certificate' as shown in 'Annex D'.

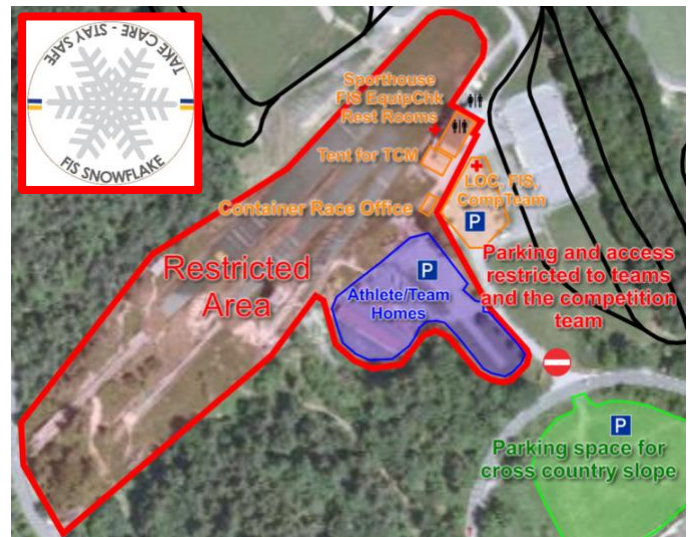
On-Site COVID-19 test possibility:

As a backup for certified COVID-19 tests, the LOC facilitates an onsite nasal swab antigen test, conducted by Red Cross first aid personnel. Team Captains needs to inform the LOC Health coordinator (Franz Wiegele +43 676 838 40228) latest by Wednesday Feb. 17th if no proof of a negative medical certificate with the above criteria can be presented. The onsite test doesn't qualify for other purposes than accreditation, thus we don't issue a formal medical certificate!

Concerned team members can be tested on Friday between 17-19h (prior to the TCM with a cost contribution of €25/tested person. The fee can be paid by the teams cashless with an ATM card.

A positive test result will be reported to local authorities ☎ 1450 whom will apply procedures for contact tracing and isolation in accordance with national regulations. The affected team will be excluded from the competition.

A breach of discipline protocol will also lead to withdrawal of accreditation.



Daily Health Check

Based on OESV / Austrian Ski Federation guidelines every single competitor, coach, staff and LOC members need to fill out a 'Registration & Covid-19 Health Questionnaire' by using this link:

Detailed information – when you must fill out this form - will be presented at the Team Captains Meeting.

In case a team member shows symptoms (fever, chest pain, headache, nausea/vomiting or loss of taste/smell) inform immediately the LOC COVID-19 Health Coordinator – to align on further proceeding.

Masks

Every person in the restricted area of the Villacher-Alpen-Arena must wear a FFP2 or equivalent KN95 mask without exhaust valve.

Exceptions: When drinking or eating and athletes during sport. Athletes may remove the mask after equipment check at the starting area of the hill. In addition, every Person must maintain a 2m distance from other persons.


TCM





The TCM will take place in a 70²m tent in front of the Arena-Café with a ≥ 2 m distance between attendees. Only the Team Captain or one representative of each competing team can attend the TCM in person. Jumping judges are also represented by one representative. Additional people can attend online via ZOOM meeting. A link will be provided prior to the TCM.

Team-Home and Toilet Facilities

Venue facilities and restricted areas are indicated schematic on page 5. The toilet facilities next to 'FIS Equipment Check' room, is restricted to participants of the event only. Please keep always the 2m minimum distance to other people.

We ask EVERYONE, to TAKE RESPONSIBILITY and comply by all means with requirements and guidelines as listed above! Stewards and LOC members might check and enforce the COVID-19 requirements. We will be most effective, if EVERYONE simply adheres to the requirements for his/her own safety and the safety of others. In case of violation or non-compliance with the COVID-19 guidelines, we reserve the right to exclude concerned persons from the event and take legal action.
